In the year 2011 we lost him. May Allah rest his soul in peace and give forbearance to his family. The friends of Dr. Tariq Javed (late) including Dr. Bashir A. Qureshi, Professor Saif Ullah and Dr. Mazhar Iqbal has launched a financial assistantship for the needy student of Economics. In this category THIRTY FOUR Financial Assistantships, (worth 6,65,419 rupees) are availed by the poor talented students of Quaid-i-Azam University.

2. Salman Sohail Financial Assistantships (SSFA):

Salman Sohail was one of the brilliant student of the School of Economics. We lost him in 2010 as a result of a sorrowful incident. Though, now Salman is not with us. Indeed, he will remain in our memories for ever. May Allah rest his soul in peace and give patience to his parents, sisters and other family members. QAU Welfare Society on behalf of the parents of Salman Sohail and his friend Ali Sumbul announces financial assistantships for the needy students of the School of Economics. In this category NINETEEN Financial Assistantships, (worth 3,60,923 rupees) are availed by the students of Quaid-i-Azam University.

3. Musharraf Zarif Financial Assistantships (MZFA):

These financial assistantships are sponsored by one of the alumni of the School of Economics, Quaid-i-Azam University in memory of his parents. The main objective of MZFA is to promote education in Pakistan by providing financial assistance to those who have the talent but find it difficult to pursue their higher studies at Quaid-i-Azam University. This support program is initiated by one of the alumni of School of Economics, Quaid-i-Azam University with the slogan that Allah All Mighty has bestowed us with two hands one for helping our self and one for helping others. Helping others is always considered a voluntary act but in fact it is extremely important to help other people as it leads to sustainability and overall betterment of society. With the same purpose, Helping Hands Support Program is initiated to stay connected with our roots, our alma mater & serve our society in best possible way that we can. This support program was initiated in Spring 2015 and TWENTY ONE Financial Assistantships, (worth 4,23,848 rupees) are availed by the students of Quaid-i-Azam University.

5. V-58 Quaidians Support Program (V-58 QSP):

Alumni of M.Sc. Economics 2003-05 batch comes together to pay back a fragment of what they received from School of Economics, Quaid-i-Azam University. Under the V58 Quaidians Support Program need-based financial assistantships will be awarded to the continuing students of BS Economics who are not in receipt of any other financial aid/scholarship. This support program was initiated in Spring 2015 and in this regard SIX need based financial assistantship (worth 1,39,765 rupees) is awarded to the student of BS Economics.

6. Prof. Muhammad Aslam Financial Assistantships (PMAFA):

Prof. Muhammad Aslam (b. 1932, d. 1998) is a renowned historian and academic of Pakistan, who served in the Department of History, University of the Punjab, Lahore, for thirty five years with utmost dedication and commitment to the institution he served, as well as to the discipline of history. In his memory and recognition of his services, his family (especially Ms. Zamila Farzana and Mr. Farooq Nafey) has launched financial assistantships for the needy students of the Department of History, Quaid-i-Azam University, Islamabad. In this category THIRTY SIX Financial Assistantships, (worth 5,78,554 rupees) are availed by the students of Quaid-i-Azam University.

7. Mr. & Mrs. Sheikh Karamat Ullah Support Program (SKASP):

This support program was initiated by Mr. Faisal Nadeem (late) son of Mr. & Mrs. Sheikh Karamat Ullah (late). Under this category need-based financial assistantships were awarded to the continuing student of M.Phil. Economics. This support program was initiated in Spring – 2016 and in this regard FOUR need based financial assistantships (worth 1,01,206 rupees) was awarded to the deserving student of M.Phil. Economics. This support program had discontinued due to the death of Mr. Faisal Nadeem. May Allah Pak rest his soul in peace (amen).

8. Dr. Syed Mujawar Hussain Shah Support Program (DSMHSSP).

Dr. Syed Muhawar Hussain Shah served as a research fellow at the Chair on Quaid-i-Azam and Freedom Movement, National Institute for Pakistan Studies (NIPS), Quaid-i-Azam University (QAU) for 1990-1995. Later on he also served as Deputy Controller of Examinations at QAU. He also taught at NIPS. This support program is initiated by one of his student. So far SEVEN need based financial assistantships (worth 1,02,291 rupees) are availed by the students of Quaid-i-Azam University.

9. Maulana Abdul Bari Nadvi Financial Assistantship (MABNFA)

Maulana Abdul Bari Nadvi (b. 1886-d. 1976) was a renowned scholar who taught philosophy and religion at Gujrat College in Ahmedabad, Dakkan College in Poona and Usmania University in Hyderabad, from where he retired as Professor and Head of the Philosophy Department. He was one of the most capable students of Allama Shibli Naumani. He received religious education from Maulana Ashraf Ali Thanvi and Maulana Ahmad Madni. He wrote extensively on religion and philosophy and translated works of numerous westerns philosophers such as Berkely, Hume, Descartes, Dewey, Henry Bergson, William James and G.F. Stout. This support program is initiated by his student. In this category so far THREE financial assistantships (worth 48,987 rupees) are awarded to the needy students of Quaid-i-Azam University.
