FINANCIAL ASSISTANTSHIPS AWARDED IN SPRING SEMESTER - 2021

QAU Welfare Society (QWS) is a non-political forum. Its purpose is to work as volunteer for the welfare of community. It works on humanitarian grounds; therefore, any deserving person can be the beneficiary of QWS. It works under the patronage of Honorable Vice Chancellor of the University and is governed by an Advisory Board comprised of university teachers. The students of various departments work as volunteer. QWS gives financial assistance to a significant number of students in every semester and carries out welfare activities in natural disasters like flood and earthquake etc. The welfare generating activities requires time and contribution of money. QWS is not being sponsored by any funding body. It generates funds at its own through personal links and conducting fund raising activities at the campus. Obviously, the need for funds is much higher than what can be collected from within the University only. In this regard we appeal for more donations. Philanthropists are requested to contribute by giving donations or announcing financial assistantship.

QAU Welfare Society was formed in March 2011, since then it has awarded **Four Hundred and Nine Need Based Financial Assistantships, worth 7,227,081 rupees**. All payments, except 18 (serial 128, 157 to 167, 216 to 218, 220 to 222 and 300), were made through cross cheques in favor of university account titled "Fees and Dues". **Thirty-nine need based financial assistantships (worth 798,676 rupees) were awarded in Spring Semester – 2021**. Tariq Javed Financial Assistantships

(Since Spring 2013)

In the year 2011 we lost him. May Allah rest his soul in peace and give forbearance to his family. The friends of Dr. Tariq Javed (late) including Dr. Bashir A. Qureshi, Professor Saif Ullah and Dr. Mazhar Iqbal launched financial assistantships for the needy student of Quaid-i-Azam University. In this category **54 Need Based Financial Assistantships, worth 1,150,168 rupees** are availed by the students during last ten years.

Helping Hands Support Program

(Since Spring 2015)

This support program is initiated by one of the alumni of School of Economics, Quaid-i-Azam University with the slogan that Allah All Mighty has bestowed us with two hands one for helping our self and one for helping others. In his memory and recognition of his services, his family (especially Mrs. Rehana Aslam, Ms. Zamila Farzana and Mr. Farooq Nafey) has launched financial assistantships for the needy students of the Department of History, Quaid-i-Azam University, Islamabad. Prof. Muhammad Aslam Financial Assistantship was initiated in September 2015. During three years **97 Need Based Financial Assistantships worth 16,34,470 rupees** are availed by the students of Quaid-i-Azam University.

Salman Sohail Financial Assistantships

(Since Fall 2011)

Salman Sohail was one of the brilliant student of the School of Economics. We lost him in 2010 as a result of a sorrowful incident. Though, now Salman is not with us. Indeed, he will remain in our memories for ever. May Allah rest his soul in peace and give patience to his parents, sisters and other family members. QAU Welfare Society on behalf of the mother of Salman Sohail awards financial assistantships to the needy students of the School of Economics. In this category **27 Need Based Financial Assistantships worth 5,51,454 rupees** are availed by the students.

Dr. Mujawar Hussain Shah Support Program

(Since Spring 2016)

Dr. Mujawar Hussain Shah was the notable personality of Quaid-i-Azam University. He served at various key positions in Quaid-i-Azam University. He served at various key position including Controller of Examinations. One of his apprentices launched this support program to pay a tribute to his teacher. Dr. Mujawar Hussain Support Program” is launched for the needy students of National Institute of Pakistan Studies. This program was initiated in September 2016. In four rounds **23 financial assistantships worth 3,63,581 rupees** are awarded to the needy students of Pakistan Studies

Baba Jan Sarkar Dr. M. Youssuf Shaheen Support Program

(Since Spring 2018)

Baba Jan Sarkar, Dr. Muhammad Youssuf Shaheen Shah Qadir Qalandar (1938-2016) was by profession a medical doctor with additional qualification in homeopathy and acupuncture, who served as a surgeon and physician for over fifty years, first in Baluchistan and later in Jhang, Punjab. That was only a bit of his service and benevolence to humanity. As a spiritual guide and a Sufi master, he healed and illuminated the hearts and minds of thousands of people for an even longer time. This support program was initiated to promote research on Sufism and later on extended to all needy students. In this category so far **24 Financial Assistantships worth 4,31,001 rupees** are awarded to the research students of Quaid-i-Azam University.

Maulana Abdul Bari Nadvi Support Program

(Since Spring 2017)

Maulana Abdul Bari Nadvi (b. 1886-d. 1976) was a renowned scholar who taught philosophy and religion at Gujrat College in Ahmedabad, Dakkan College in Poona and Usmania University in Hyderabad, from where he retired as Professor and Head of the Philosophy Department. He was one of the most capable students of Allama Shibli Naumani. He received religious education from Maulana Ashraf Ali Thanvi and Maulana Ahmad Madni. He wrote extensively on religion and philosophy and translated works of numerous westerns philosophers such as Berkely, Hume, Descartes, Dewey, Henry Bergson, William James and G.F. Stout. This support program is initiated by his student. In this category so far **12 Need Based Financial Assistantships worth 2,00,399 rupees** are awarded to the needy students of Quaid-i-Azam University.

Shahryar Award for Needy Students

(Since Spring 2020)

This support program is initiated by the Chairman of Nadir Foundation Trust, who is the alumnus of Quaid-i-Azam University. He initiated this support program in the memory of Shahryar Ashraf Malik (late) who voluntary worked to promote education in rural areas. This support program is an effort to continue the mission of Shahryar and promote education. QAU Welfare Society on behalf of Nadir Foundation Trust awards financial assistantships to the needy students of Quaid-i-Azam University. This program was initiated in semester Spring – 2020 and so far, **three** students are awarded need based **financial assistantship worth 40,872 rupees**.
