



FIRST REPORT OF TEACH THE TALENT PROGRAM
Reporting Period: September 2020 – March 2021

Education is the fundamental right of all human beings. It not only helps individuals to become better citizens but also enhances their skills and promotes employability. Every child needs education. However, in our surroundings there are numerous street children who do not have access to schools and are thus deprived of education.

Last year in August, QAU Welfare Society initiated “Teach the Talent” program. The idea was to sponsor educational expenditures of children belonging to low income / poor households who cannot afford to educate their children.

It is pleasures to share that in first phase 5 children are adopted by our donors. These children are enrolled in EFA School System, Bari Imam. All expenditures including school fee, uniform, books and copies from September 2020 to March 2021 are deposited via cross cheques. Given below are the details:

An Overview of QAU Welfare Society

QAU Welfare Society (QWS) is a non-political forum. Its purpose is to work as volunteer for the welfare of community. It works on humanitarian grounds; therefore, any deserving person can be the beneficiary of QWS. It is not being sponsored by any funding body. It generates funds at its own. The working body of QWS has no political motives. It works under the patronage of Honorable Vice Chancellor of the University and is governed by an advisory board comprising of university teachers and senior alumni.

- The financial assistantship cell of QAU Welfare Society awarded 370 financial assistantships worth **6,425,253** rupees to the needy students of Quaid-i-Azam University. (March 2011 to January 2021)
- The emergency disaster cell of QAU Welfare Society distributed goods worth **5,21,4563** rupees among the families affected during floods of 2010, 2012 and 2014. Last year this cell disbursed goods worth **2,579,338 rupees** among the deserving families / individuals who were adversely affected due to Coronavirus pandemic.
- In 2016 the community welfare cell of QAU Welfare Society distributed 20 wheelchairs and 20 gent suits among disabled citizens of Abbottabad and Rawalpindi. Since 2017 society is distributing ration bags and suits (ladies and gents) among the low-income families of surroundings. Last year 72 Parachute Jackets (with woolen filling) and 34 woolen Gents Shawls were given to daily wage employees residing in Bari Imam. Apart from these, society donated for famine in Thar and carried out many other welfare activities.
- The blood donation cell of QAU Welfare Society organized three blood donation camps.
