SECOND WINTER RELIEF CAMPAIGN OF QAU WELFARE SOCIETY (December 2020 – January 2021)

In December 2020, QAU Welfare Society initiated a '**Winter Relief Campaign**' for street children of surroundings. The idea was to distribute jackets and woolen sweaters among the street children of city. In this regard a fund-raising campaign was initiated at very small scale by engaging few individuals including faculty members and alumni.

It is pleasures to share that volunteers of QAU Welfare Society distributed **105 Parachute Jackets** (with woolen lining), **100 woolen sweaters** and **15 quilts** among deserving children of Bari Imam and Mahra Abadi, Islamabad. The distribution was carried out in five phases.

1. Street Children of Nurpur Shahan, Bari Imam



The volunteers of QAU Welfare Society conducted a survey and listed 30 boys & girls. Most of the listed children work as child labor in Bari Imam & surroundings. On December 22,



2020 these children were gathered in a ground of university colony and they were given jackets.

2. Students of Mashal Model School, Nurpur Shahan, Bari Imam

Mashal Model School is a charity school in which provide free education to deprived children. The volunteers of QAU Welfare Society contacted the administration of this school and asked them to identify 25 most deserving children. On December 24, 2020 our volunteers visited the

school and distributed 25 Jackets.



The administration of school requested for quilts and more jackets. On January 7, 2021 another 30 jackets and 15 quilts were





distributed among already identified children. Therefore, students of Mashal Model School were provided 55 Parachute Jackets (with woolen lining) and 15 quilts.

We are thankful to the school administration for their cooperation and arranging a distribution ceremony.

3. Students of EFA School System, Nurpur Shahan, Bari Imam

EFA School System is another school in the vicinity of Bari Imam. A significant number of unprivileged children are enrolled in this school. The volunteers of QAU Welfare Society contacted the administration of this school and asked them to identify most deserving children. The school administration provided a list of six deserving children. On January 8, 2021 our volunteers provided them 6 parachute Jackets (with woolen lining). The school administration distributed these jackets and shared details with QAU Welfare Society.



Apart for these, another 14 jackets were randomly distributed among street children of surroundings.

4. Students of OSCP / IFEEL, F – 11 / 4, Islamabad



OSCS (Out of School Children School) is another charity school. It provides free education to deprived children. The main office of this school is in F-11/4. The volunteers of QAU Welfare Society contacted the administration of this school and asked about the urgent need of deserving children regarding school uniform sweaters. They requested for 100



woolen sweaters of different sizes. These sweaters were provided to them on January 18, 2021 and eventually the sweaters were distributed among the students of I-8 branch of this school.

5. Random Distribution in Surroundings of Bari Imam

We received ten ladies' sweaters and four gents' jackets from one of our donors. These jackets and sweaters were randomly distributed in Mohallah Dhaki, Nurpur Shahan.

Statement of Donations and Expenditures

It is worth mentioning that funds raising campaign was launched at a very small scale by engaging few individuals including faculty members and alumni. We received donations of 150,000 rupees. All donations were deposited in bank account of QAU Welfare Society. 119,900 rupees were spent on the purchase of 105 parachute jackets, 100 school uniform sweaters and 15 quilts. Given below is the summary of donations and expenditures:

Withholding tax on bank withdrawals and cost of transportation were taken up by QAU Welfare Society. There is no distribution cost. Donations were spent merely on the purchase of goods. The unused amount of 30,100 rupees shall be utilized for the support of deprived children in future.

An Overview of QAU Welfare Society

QAU Welfare Society (QWS) is a non-political forum. Its purpose is to work as volunteer for the welfare of community. It works on humanitarian grounds; therefore, any deserving person can be the beneficiary of QWS. It is not being sponsored by any funding body. It generates funds at its own. The working body of QWS has no political motives. It works under the patronage of Honorable Vice Chancellor of the University and is governed by an advisory board comprising of university teachers and senior alumni.

- The financial assistantship cell of QAU Welfare Society awarded 370 financial assistantships worth **6,425,253** rupees to the needy students of Quaid-i-Azam University. (March 2011 to January 2021)
- The emergency disaster cell of QAU Welfare Society distributed goods worth **5,21,4563** rupees among the families affected during floods of 2010, 2012 and 2014. Last year this cell disbursed goods worth **2,579,338 rupees** among the deserving families / individuals who were adversely affected due to Coronavirus pandemic.
- In 2016 the community welfare cell of QAU Welfare Society distributed 20 wheelchairs and gent suits among disabled citizens of Abbottabad and Rawalpindi. Since 2017 society is distributing ration bags and suits (ladies and gents) among the low-income families of

surroundings. Last year 72 Parachute Jackets (with woolen filling) and 34 woolen Gents Shawls were given to daily wage employees residing in Bari Imam. Apart from these, society donated for famine in Thar and carried out many other welfare activities.

- The blood donation cell of QAU Welfare Society organized three blood donation camps.
