## RAMZAN RELIEF CAMPAIGN - 2021

## 1. Executive Summary

In April 2021, QAU Welfare Society initiated "Ramzan Relief Campaign", the idea was to provide ration bags to the deprived households. In this regard a call for donation was given through email and social media. We are thankful to our donors for their overwhelming response, Alhomdolila **donations of 5,08,000 rupees** were received. These donations were spent on the purchase of goods and additional cost including packing, transportation and withholding tax was paid by QAU Welfare Society. Two hundred ration bags were distributed among the deprived households in five rounds.

# 2. Complete Report

The emergency disaster cell of QAU Welfare Society initiated a ration drive for the poor families. In this regard a fund-raising campaign was initiated in first week of April 2021. Our call for donations was well responded and we received enough donations from different individuals and in particular from the faculty and alumni of Quaid-i-Azam University. We are thankful to all donors for their support and trust.

The distribution of ration bags was mainly confined to the surroundings of Quaid-i-Azam university, however we also approached to Katcha Morr, a village of Hasan Abdal. It is to share that **five consignments** comprising of **200** ration bags worth **5,16,732 rupees** were distributed among deserving households. It is pertinent to mention that withholding tax on banks withdrawals (**3,082** rupees) and packing cost / transportation cost (**5,860** rupees) was taken up by QAU Welfare Society and donations were merely used to purchase goods. Given below is a summary of all consignments.

### 2.1. First Consignment of Ramzan Ration Drive - 2021

The first consignment was delivered on April 17, 2020. **Fifty Ration bags** worth **137,882 rupees** were distributed in surroundings of Quaid-i-Azam university, villages near Barakoh and Faizabad. We are highly thankful our alumnus Muhammad Ashfaq for his volunteer services in purchasing, packing and delivering ration bags. Special thanks to Ms. Hira Mansoor for identifying the deserving families and distribution of ration bags. The details of consumption bundle and expenditures are reported in Table 1.

# 2.2 Second Consignment of Ration Drive - 2021

Our second consignment of Ramzan Ration Drive – 2021 was distributed among the deserving families of village Katcha Morr in District Hasan Abdal. We are again thankful to our alumni Muhammad Ashfaq who not only purchased goods but also distributed ration bags among the deserving families of locality. This

consignment was delivered on April 30, 2020. **Thirty Ration bags** worth **76,446 rupees** were distributed in village Katcha Morr. The details of consumption bundle and expenditures are reported in Table 2.

Third consignment of 50 ration bags was distributed May 1, 2021. This was also confined to the poor families in the surroundings of Quaid-i-Azam university, villages near Barakoh and Faizabad. More than 80% families of first consignment were repeated. We are especially thankful to Mr. Tahir Khattak, university employee and our alumnus Ms. Hira Mansoor who distributed goods among already identified families. These ration bags were supplied by Saiban Traders @ 2,500 per bag. The details of consumption bundle and expenditures are reported in Table 3.

### 2.4 Fourth Consignment of Ration Drive - 2021

Forth consignment of Ramzan Ration Drive – 2021 was distributed on May 8, 2021. Thirty ration bags comprising of basic food items were distributed in the surroundings of Quaid-i-Azam University and Barakoh. Ration bags were purchased from Saiban Traders @ 2,500 per bag. The details of consumption bundle and expenditures are reported in Table 4.

# 2.5 Fifth Consignment of Ration Drive - 2021

Fifth and last consignment of this drive was distributed on May 11, 2021. This consignment of 40 bags was distributed in village Katcha Morr, a village of Hasan Abdal. Special thanks to Muhammad Ashfaq for his support in purchasing, packing and distribution of goods. In this consignment all beneficiaries of second consignment were repeated and few additional were also covered. A summary of goods and expenditures is given in Table 5.

### 4 An Overview of QAU Welfare Society

QAU Welfare Society (QWS) is a non-political forum. Its purpose is to work as volunteer for the welfare of community. It works on humanitarian grounds; therefore, any deserving person can be the beneficiary of QWS. It is not being sponsored by any funding body. It generates funds at its own. The working body of QWS has no political motives. It works under the patronage of Honorable Vice Chancellor of the University and is governed by an advisory board comprising of university teachers and senior alumni.

- The financial assistantship cell of QAU Welfare Society awarded 409 financial assistantships worth
   7,227,081 rupees to the needy students of Quaid-i-Azam University. (March 2011 to April 2021).
- In 2020, the emergency disaster cell of QAU Welfare Society disbursed 1281 ration bags and 400 ration kits worth 2,579,338 rupees among the deserving families / individuals who were adversely affected due to Coronavirus pandemic.
- The emergency disaster cell of QAU Welfare Society distributed goods worth 5,21,4563 rupees among the families affected during floods of 2010, 2012 and 2014
- In 2016 the community welfare cell of QAU Welfare Society distributed 20 wheelchairs and gent suits among disabled citizens of Abbottabad and Rawalpindi. Since 2017 society is distributing ration bags and suits (ladies and gents) among the low-income families of surroundings. Last year QAU Welfare Society launched two winter relief campaigns. In first campaign 72 Parachute Jackets (with woolen filling) and 34 woolen Gents Shawls were given to daily wage employees residing in Bari Imam. In second campaign, another 105 Parachute Jackets (with woolen lining), 100 woolen sweaters and 15 quilts were distributed among deserving children. Apart from these, QAU Welfare Society donated for famine in Thar and carried out many other welfare activities. The blood donation cell of QAU Welfare Society organized three blood donation camps.
- In August 2020, QAU Welfare Society initiated "**Teach the Talent**" program to educate children of poor families. In first phase 5 children were adopted and currently **7 children** are getting regular education though this scheme. QAU Welfare Society is bearing their educational expenditures including school fee, uniform, and books.
