SUPPORTING NEEDY STUDENTS THROUGH LOAN

The QAU Welfare Society occasionally extends support to deserving students through short-term, interest-free loans. The purpose is to ensure the continuation of education without interruptions due to short period financial constraints. These loans are generally granted for a period of six months to one year, depending on the student's need and circumstances.

To date, the Society has provided loans to 15 students of different departments, out of which 12 have successfully repaid their loans, reflecting both their sense of responsibility and the revolving nature of this support system. This repayment enables the Society to assist more students in need, creating a cycle of compassion and sustainability.
