RAMZAN RELIEF CAMPAIGN - 2026

1. Executive Summary

During the holy month of Ramzan 2026, the QAU Welfare Society organized its annual Ramzan Ration Drive to support low-income and deserving families. Under this initiative, 91 ration bags, worth a total of PKR 265,334, were distributed among financially disadvantaged households in Hassan Abdal, the surrounding areas of Quaid-i-Azam University and selected deserving families in Islamabad.

The initiative aimed to ease the financial burden of vulnerable families during the blessed month of Ramzan and enable them to observe the month with greater dignity and peace of mind. This welfare activity was made possible through the generous support of our donors, whose continued contributions allow the Society to extend timely assistance to those most in need.

2. Complete Report

The distribution of ration bags was primarily focused on the communities surrounding Quaid-i-Azam University, where many low-income families were identified through local outreach. In addition, the QAU Welfare Society extended its support to deserving families in Katcha Morr, a village near Hasan Abdal, as well as a number of financially disadvantaged households in different areas of Islamabad. The following table provides a summary of the distribution by location.
